Why do I need ADA certification?

ADA certification enables you to get more trips and make more money as a driver. By becoming ADA certified you will qualify for tens of thousands of trips offered by the MTA each month, including but not limited to Access-A-Ride (AAR) trips under the agency's new program.

How do I get ADA certified?

Just three things are required to become ADA certified:

- 1. Schedule and complete an ADA training course at CMT.
- 2. Complete a pre-enrollment drug test (administered immediately following your training course).
- 3. Participate in random drug and alcohol testing throughout the year.

How much does it cost?

The cost for training and drug testing is **FREE for the first 500 drivers** that sign up. After this initial group, participants will be required to pay and that amount will be added to our website for your convenience.

Where will the training take place?

Training classes will take place at ARRO's main office: **42-32 21st. St. Long Island City, NY 11101.** Email marketing@ridearro.com for questions about parking.

How long will the training take?

Training will take approximately 2 hours. Drug and alcohol testing will be handled at designated testing centers, so the amount of time for testing will depend on their schedules and demand. Some facilities have drivers in and out in less than 30 minutes.

What happens once I complete the training?

You will be notified that you are Certified and you will get immediate access to the largest pool of MTA trips.

Is this training mandatory?

This training is required for all drivers who wish to receive additional MTA trips and earn more money.

Will I still receive MTA trips if I don't do this Certification?

You will still be eligible to receive some MTA trips, but enrolling in the Certification program gives you access to ALL types of MTA trips.

Is drug testing required?

Yes. A pre-enrollment drug test is required to be considered for the program (just as required for obtaining your TLC license).

Am I required to take the pre-enrollment drug test if I already took a drug test when I received/renewed my TLC license?

Yes. The drug test required by the MTA is slightly different and therefore must be done separately.

What does it mean to participate in "random drug and alcohol testing"?

Ongoing drug and alcohol testing is part of the MTA's requirement for certification. Over the course of the year, you may be randomly selected to take an additional drug or alcohol test.

Is this only for Wheelchair Drivers?

No. This is for all drivers.

Do I have to renew my ARRO ADA Certification?

You will be required to complete a brief refresher course once per year, but you will not have to retake the pre-enrollment drug test.
